

Businessman gets bail in sex case

The businessman, whose wife filed a complaint of section 377 of the Indian Penal Code (unnatural sex) against him was granted anticipatory bail by a sessions court on Saturday. In her complaint, Rohini Mathur states that she became aware of her husband Ashok's homosexuality in 1998. In 2007, Mathur confessed before the counsellor that he found a partner, Fernandes and was having sexu-

al relations with him.

On Febraury 16, Rohini filed a FIR with Gamdevi police station after which the police seized two CDs which, according to them, had incriminating material against the accused.

Mathur's lawyer, Vivek Kantawala argued that the couple has been living together and that no proceeding has been initiated in the family court. This complaint has been made to harass my client, said Kantawala.
